Here are some local agencies and programs providing affordable food and meal options.

Community Food & Friends

- Canmore Food & Friends Every Monday from 5-7 PM, Food & Friends operates from St. Michael's Hall (709-7th Street), currently offering take-out food. Please bring your own container, or one can be provided. Details are similar to Banff, below.
- Banff Food & Friends Every Monday from 5-7 PM is operating from St. George's-in-the-Pines (100 Beaver Street) currently offering take-out food. The price is free, but donations are welcome and can be made at the door.
 - If you are symptom free, bring your mask and come get dinner to take with you. They practice safe distancing and require everyone to wear a mask and sanitize hands upon entry. Compostable take-out containers are provided.
 - They hope to be able to gather in person again once it is safe to do so, and have meals together at the church. Until then they are happy to offer take-away food. They are also looking for volunteers who can help out at 4 pm so if you're free, email info@stgeorgesinthepines.com.


Bow Valley Good Food Box

The regular price of the Bow Valley Good Food Box is \$30, taxes included. This is open to anyone in the Bow Valley. A partially subsidized option of \$25 is offered to people with a lower-income* or who have been affected by COVID-19. These subsidies are provided by a grant from the Rotary Club of Canmore and the Bow Valley Christmas Spirit Campaign.
